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In the event that the payer becomes incapacitated or incarcerated for 180 days or more, the payer's child support may be suspended effective the date the Friend of the Court provides notice of the suspension to the parties, unless incarceration is due to failure to pay support. The Friend of the Court will provide the payee with notice and an opportunity to object within 21 days to the suspension of the payers child support. If an objection is timely received, the FOC will schedule a hearing. This provision will have the same force and effect of a Petition for Modification and satisfies the requirements of MCL 552.603. Following suspension of support, the reinstatement date for child support will be the date the payer is released from incarceration, or is no longer incapacitated. The Friend of the Court will initiate a review of the child support order within 90 days of the reinstatement of support.



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
