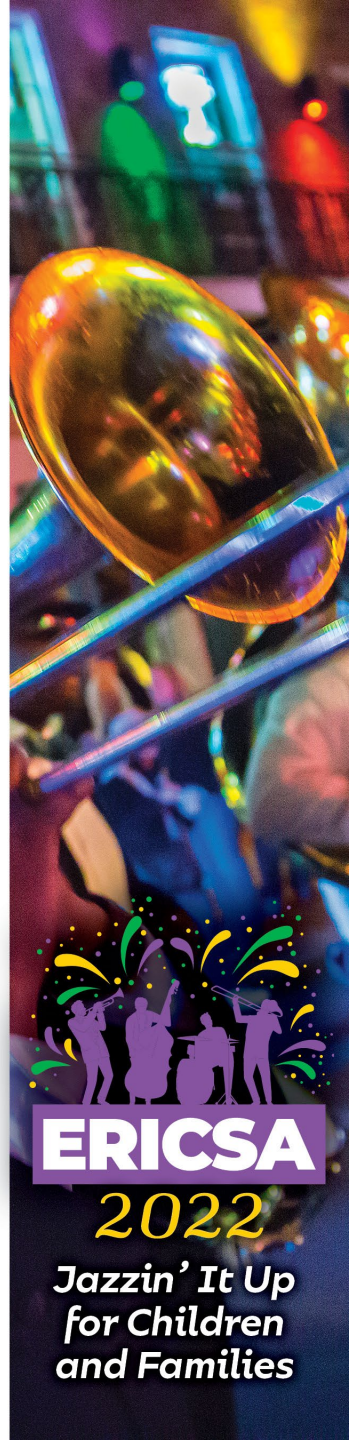

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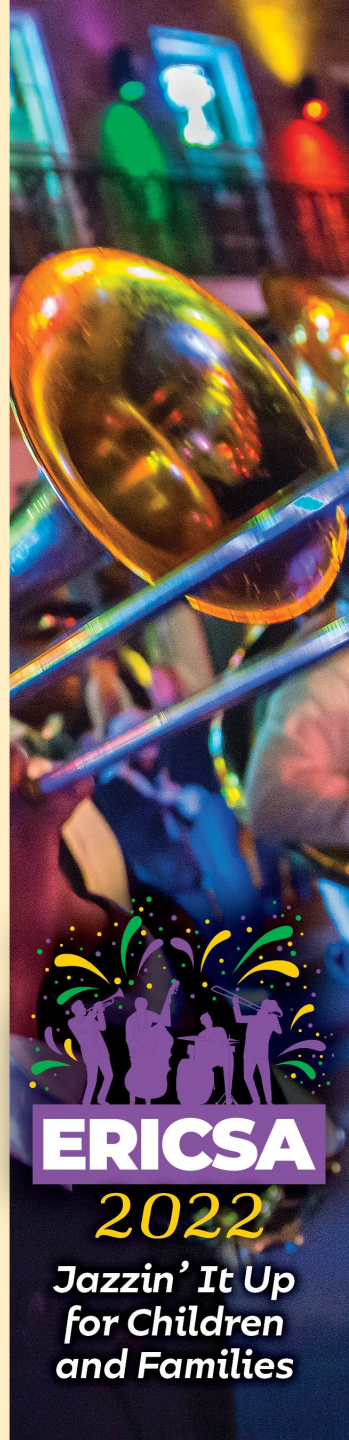
Purpose

- This workshop will review how the interstate child support practice has changed as we have been slowly coming out of the pandemic and adjusting to a new, virtual world.



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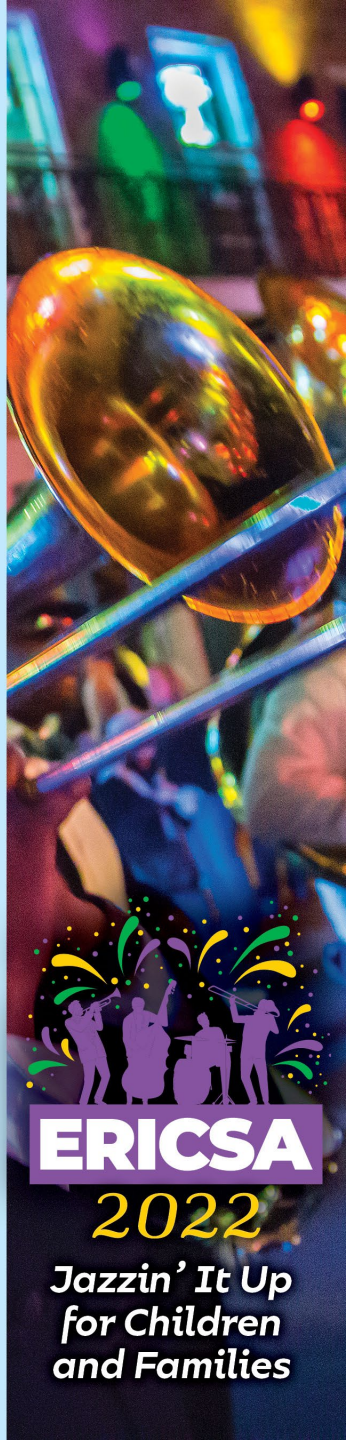

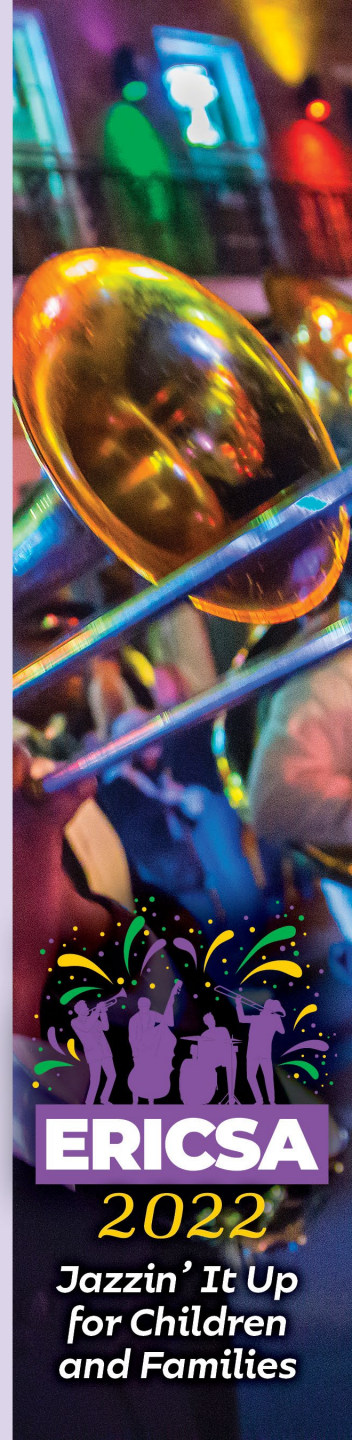

Session Methodology



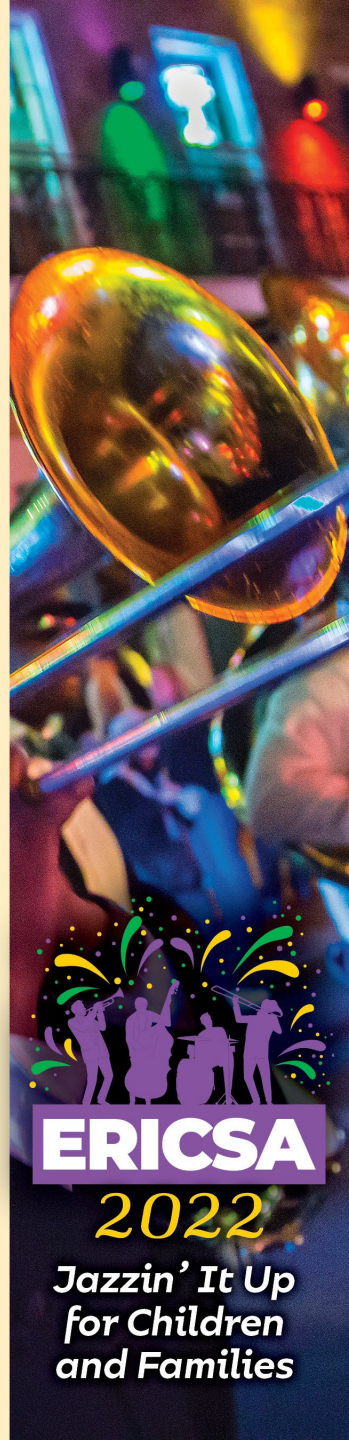
- The workshop is divided into several sections;
