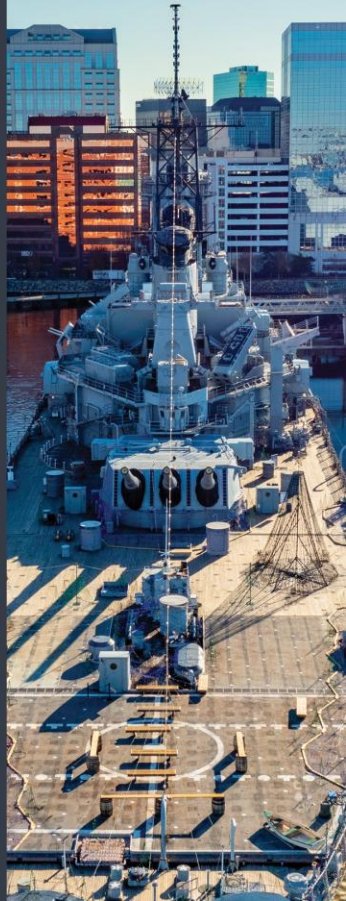

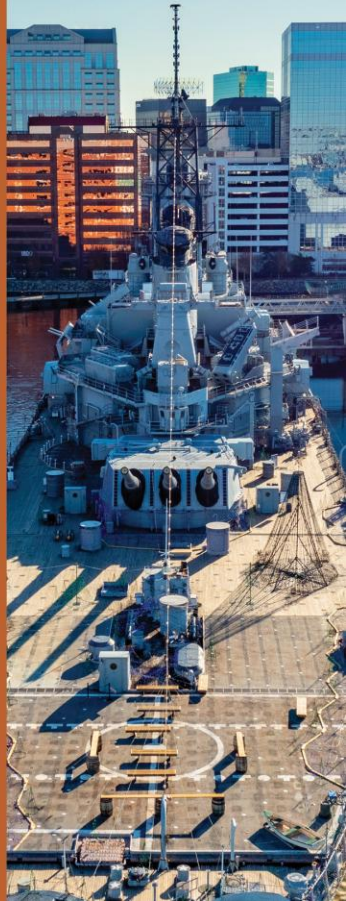


Welcome to what will be an engaging and interactive session designed for quick, small-group mentoring with ten established women leaders in the child support community.

Women can face unique challenges and barriers advancing to and in positions of leadership. Through small-group discussions and expert facilitation, mentors will offer valuable support and resources to participants.

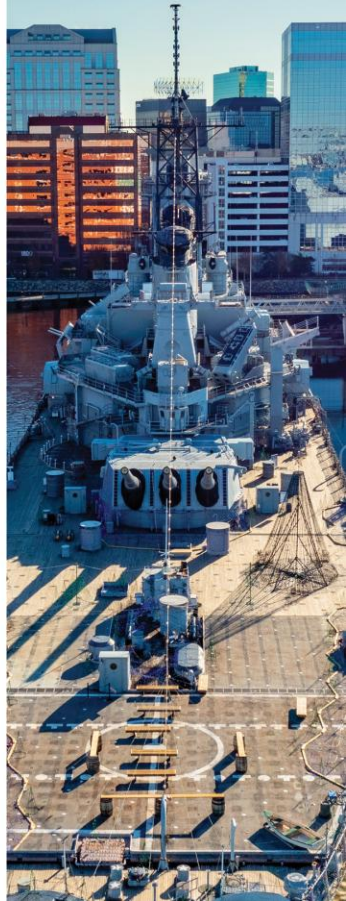
