Dear MR MOUSE:

Please be advised that your case has been reviewed for a possible reduction in the balance of child support and/or birthing expenses owed to the Cabinet for Health and Family Services (CHFS). You have been chosen to participate in a program wherein the amount owed may be compromised by 25 percent to 80 percent under certain conditions.

Currently, you owe a balance of \$11,500.00 to CHFS. Please find enclosed an Arrearage Compromise Agreement that reduces the balance owed provided that you make consistent payments as ordered.

For consistent weekly payments of \$50.00 for six months, your estimated balance would be lowered to \$7,325.00 and the estimated balance in twelve months would be lowered to \$2,362.50. If you are eligible for a compromise of 80 percent, the estimated balance is reflected on the enclosed agreement. If payments stop at any time during the pendency of this Agreement, the beginning balance is automatically reinstated with credit given only for payments made.

If you are interested in entering into this Agreement, please review the enclosed document, sign and return to: Child Support Division, 315 West Muhammad Ali Blvd., ATTN: JEFF HENRY, Louisville, KY 40202, within 20 days.

I am authorized to accept the amount of \$2,600.00 as payment in full. Written notice of your intent to make the lump sum payment is required within ten (10) days and the payment must be made within 45 days of the date of this letter.

In this agreement, beginning on MAY 1, 2011, the obligor MICKEY MOUSE, shall pay current support of \$40.00 per WEEK in accordance with the order entered on MAY 1, 2011. She/he shall pay an additional amount of \$10.00 per WEEK toward the arrearage of \$11,500.00 owed to the Cabinet for Health and Family Services as of APRIL 30, 2011. The obligor is responsible for making payments pursuant to the attached Payment Instruction Sheet until such time as payments are withheld from the obligor's wages.

In consideration of the obligor's strict performance of the payment of the child support obligation listed above, the agent for the Cabinet for Health and Family Services agrees as follows:

1. For payment as agreed for six months, a 25 percent satisfaction of the arrearage to an estimated balance of \$7,325.00 ;
2. For payment as agreed for twelve months, a 50 percent satisfaction of the arrearage to an estimated balance of \$2,362.50 ;
3. OPTIONAL. For payment as agreed for twenty-four months, an 80 percent satisfaction of the arrearage to an estimated balance of \$N/A ; and
4. For payment of \$2,600.00 within 45 days, a full satisfaction of the arrearage.

This agreement has been entered into willingly by both parties and constitutes the entire agreement. Pursuant to KRS 205.769, the Cabinet for Health and Family Services reserves the right to collect on the amount owed through federal and state tax refund offsets. There are no other promises or conditions in any other agreement, whether oral or witten.

This agreement shall terminate automatically after six months if the terms are not met.

This agreement is made effective on the date signed by the obligor by and between the Jefferson County Attorney's Office, Child Support Division, as agent for the Cabinet for Health and Family Services, and MICKEY MOUSE, obligor IV-D Case No. . In this agreement, beginning on MAY 1, 2011, the obligor MICKEY MOUSE, shall pay the amount of \$35.00 per WEEK in accordance with the order entered on MAY 1, 2011. Said payment shall go toward satisfying the arrearage of \$20,000.00 owed to the Cabinet for Health and Family Services as of APRIL 30, 2011. The obligor is responsible for making payments pursuant to the attached Payment Instruction Sheet until such time as payments are withheld from the obligor's wages.

In consideration of the obligor's strict performance of the payment of the child support obligation listed above, the agent for the Cabinet for Health and Family Services agrees as follows:

1. For payment as agreed for six months, a 25 percent satisfaction of the arrearage to an estimated balance of \$14,090.00 ;
2. For payment as agreed for twelve months, a 50 percent satisfaction of the arrearage to an estimated balance of \$6,135.00 ;
3. OPTIONAL. For payment as agreed for twenty-four months, an 80 percent satisfaction of the arrearage to an estimated balance of 135.00 ;
and
4. For payment of \$6,135.00 within 45 days, a full satisfaction of the arrearage.

This agreement has been entered into willingly by both parties and constitutes the entire agreement. Pursuant to KRS 205.769, the Cabinet for Health and Family Services reserves the right to collect on the amount owed through federal and state tax refund offsets. There are no other promises or conditions in any other agreement, whether oral or written.

This agreement shall terminate automatically after six months if the terms are not met.
